It is important that dry stone walls of historic significance are recorded before they disappear. As part of a Heritage Lottery Fund project, the Dry Stone Walling Association want to create an archive of photographs and information about local walling styles and historic features. Initially the project covers Lancashire, Cumbria, Cheshire & Greater Manchester but it will be extended nationally. We want to capture public interest and raise awareness of the aesthetic and historic value of dry stone walling in the landscape. The archive will be produced digitally for website access.

We are looking for images and associated information about any historic dry stone structures including their location, approximate age, stone type (if possible) and any general information about the wall / feature. Please use the format below to record additional information about your photograph:

Name of Feature: e.g. stile

Types: We are looking for photos of dry stone walls of different types e.g. fell walls, church walls, vertical flag or boulder walls, stiles, sheep enclosures, hog holes, gate stoops, bee boles, pinfolds, fox traps, wells, cairns, any of historic, archaeological, geological or natural history significance etc.

Location: - Ideally a 6 figure grid reference or GPS or description of location.

Brief Description: e.g. memorial seat built into wall

Acknowledgement: How would you like the photograph acknowledged
