I talk about where my inspiration comes from, and I go through a few of my images to explain my workflow when creating a composite image. My main photographic interest has always been wildlife and wildlife features strongly in many of my images, however my main love now is in the creation of composite images where I enjoy the time spent in post processing as much as time spent with a camera in my hand.</p>

<p>8th October 2024 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm Zoom</p>	<p>George Robertson - Into the Throne Room of the Mountain Gods</p> <p>A challenging travel/mountaineering photography journey over three weeks, at high altitude, on the Baltoro Glacier in the Karakoram mountains of Northern Pakistan where 4 of the world's 14 - 8000m peaks lie. The Karakoram mountains, however, are very distinctive while most of the world's highest peaks are blanketed in snow and ice, the Karakoram is an exception. The mountains are vertical jagged outlines of granite spires glistening in the sun on slopes that are often too steep for snow to lie. The Baltoro Glacier is one of the world's longest outside of the polar regions and our journey follows the glacier into the mountains. All of these aspects combine to make this a truly fascinating and photogenic region which has been visited by many of the world leading photographers including Vittoria Sello and Galen Rowell.</p>
<p>15th October 2024 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm Poynton Civic Hall</p>	<p>Lockdown Creativity - Mike McNamee FBPPA FRPS</p> <p>Mike McNamee FRPS is the editor of Professional Imagemaker magazine with a keen personal interest in creative montage. During lockdown the magazine was published uninterrupted but a series showcasing the projects being undertaken around the world by readers were featured in the magazine. It is apparently an established medical condition that trauma such as wars, disasters, lockdowns and pandemics cause people to compress and forget the timing over which they occurred. Everybody has their own story from lockdown, some bursting with creativity, others with deep sadness. Some of the most moving images were shot by readers working in medical wards under extreme pressure, fear and tiredness (as showcased by Dr Rachel Clarke's book and film, Breathless). Those removed from such stresses often found time and space to create new work, exploring the environment within the 1-mile regulatory distance from home where we were allowed to exercise. Others obtained permission to shoot editorial work in the deserted cities, producing work that cannot be exactly repeated ever again. One of the more interesting slides in Mike's presentation is a government-issued timeline of COVID-19 which details when things happened and their sequence - it is surprising how quickly the detail has faded from memory. The creative heart of the talk concentrates on the street art around the resort of New Brighton and the subsequent history of the limited edition print that was created.</p>

Most camera club members can produce individual images successfully, however working in 'themed panels' requires a different approach. It explains the 'thinking' behind constructing panels and where this method of working is most suitable. An example would be someone contemplating going for an RPS distinction, which is a totally different genre of working compared to someone contemplating the PAGB distinction.</p> <p>Images produced on a theme may not individually win awards, but when viewed as part of a panel, can look quite striking. By constructing them into themed projects, you can convey a different way of presenting your photography. There are over 20 different panels in the talk.</p> <p>Roger is a highly distinguished, multi-award-winning photographer.
