Travelling by Car

The Centre is situated towards the bottom of Fluin Lane in Frodsham. For those with SatNav the Postcode is WA6 7QN.

From the M56 junction 12 follow the signs for Frodsham. At the traffic lights cross the swing bridge over the River Weaver. You will then be on Sutton Causeway leading to Bridge Lane. Continue for 800 yards past the zebra crossing and under the pedestrian footbridge then turn **immediate** left into Fluin lane. The Community Centre is 200 yards up the hill on the right side of the road.

Travelling By Public Transport

Frodsham Railway Station is approximately 1/3 mile walk from the Centre.

Frodsham is on bus routes from Chester and Warrington.
